



# for Bushwalking on the Gold Coast

**1. BURLEIGH HEADS NATIONAL PARK, Rainforest Circuit**

Tumgun Lookout is a great place to look for humpback whales in winter and spring. (2.3km)

**2. BURLEIGH HEADS NATIONAL PARK, ocean View walk**

Great views of Gold Coast beaches on this rocky headland walk. (2.4km)

**3. LAMINGTON NATIONAL PARK FROM GREEN MOUNTAINS, Moran's Falls**

Beautiful creek and waterfall culminating in a great picnic spot with terrific views. (4.4km)

**4. LAMINGTON NATIONAL PARK FROM BINNA BURRA, cave circuit**

Great caves to explore, and a chance to see koalas, on this wonderful short walk. (5km)

**5. LAMINGTON NATIONAL PARK FROM BINNA BURRA, Tullawallal**

Visit an amazing pocket of Antarctic Beech on the summit. (5km)

**6. LAMINGTON NATIONAL PARK FROM BINNA BURRA, Gwongoorool Pool**

Zig-zag descent through rainforest to this pool on the upper reaches of the Coomera River. (6km)

**7. SPRINGBROOK NATIONAL PARK, Best of All Lookout**

Journey past ancient Antarctic Beech trees to one of the best lookouts in Queensland. (600m)

**8. SPRINGBROOK NATIONAL PARK, Natural Bridge circuit**

An amazing natural formation on Cave Creek in Numinbah Valley (swimming prohibited). (1km)

**9. TAMBORINE NATIONAL PARK, cedar creek Falls tracks**

A gorge, waterfalls and rock pools. Lookout is accessible with strollers. (lookout 500m pools 900m)

**10. TAMBORINE NATIONAL PARK, Palm Grove circuit**

Discover large stands of piccabeen palms and huge strangler figs on this walk. (2.6km)
