## Glimbing for kids in South East QLD

Frew Park, Milfon Ledges for climbing, a 5m curling slide and enclosed mesh cage 8m off the ground what goes up!!
2 Coffon Tree Forest, Scarborough Beach Park Magical climbing opportunities in gnarled cottonwood trees, within the confines of a fully fenced play area.
3 Crockatt Park, woody Point Long flying fox and spider web climbing structure complete with nautical under cover play ground.
Mf Coolum Summit Walk, Sunshine Coast This 1.6km return hike on established track will have you climb to 208m above sea level with breathtaking 360 degree views!
5 Mf NgUngUn, Glasshouse Mounfains Over 5's can climb to new heights of 253m via this 2.8km return track.
6 Kondalilla Falls Circuit, Kondalilla National Park, Blackall Ranges Stunning views, cascading 90m waterfalls and refreshing rock pools are your reward for completing this more challenging 4.7km track.
<b>Lamington National Park, McPherson Range</b> With 160km of walking trails, more than 500 waterfalls and 250 species of unique wildlife – plenty of opportunity for climbing with more lookouts than one could count (or climb!).
<b>3 Jc Slaughfer Falls,</b> Mf coof-fha The Summit Track winds 2km to rewarding Brisbane views and iceblock treat at the top. Easier is the Aboriginal Art Trial, offering great views of the Falls from the overhanging platform.
Best of All Lookout, Springbrook National Park, Gold Coast Hinterland Easy 700m return walk to breath taking views of Mt Warning, Byron Bay and Coolangatta.
