

10 PLACES TO

Picnic in Ipswich

1 Kholo Gardens, Riverside Drive, Muirlea

Escape to the lush surrounds of Kholo with a pond, creek, boardwalks, forests and the Brisbane River. Picnic heaven!

2 Paperbark Flats Picnic Area, School Rd, Redbank Plains

Take a bushwalk and explore the massive sandstone boulders at Little White Rock and the Bluff.

3 Joseph Brady Park, 181 Riverside Avenue, Barellan Point

Where the Bremer meets the Brisbane River. Great place to fish, play and picnic!

4 Flinders Plum Picnic Area, Mt Flinders Rd, Peak crossing

Tranquil, remote picnic area surrounded by mountains and even a creek in wet seasons.

5 Hardings Paddock Picnic Area, Carmichaels Rd, Purga

Scenic picnic area featuring a bush tucker trail and bushwalks to explore.

6 Purga Nature Reserve, 840 Middle Rd, Purga

Walk among the paperbarks and keep an eye out for koalas in the gum trees.

7 Haig St Quarry Bushlands, Haig St, Brassall

Great views, walking trails, playground - plenty to explore. Look out for goannas!

8 Pan Pacific Peace Gardens, 1 McAuliffe St, Redbank

An oasis featuring a beautiful lake which is popular with water birds.

9 Pine Mountain Bush Reserve, Pine Mountain Quarry Rd, Pine Mountain

Get out of the city to this great bushland setting for a real bush picnic.

10 Colleges Crossing Reserve, Mt Crosby Rd, Chuwar

Popular riverside park with something for everyone. Bring your kayak!
