Here is a list of the sort of items that can be used in a loose parts pit. These might seem unusual play items, but they can be used endless different ways, allowing children to make anything from an obstacle course, racing car, palace or cubby!

NATURAL	Branches/leaves
Sticks – various sizes	Sand

Tree stumps	Seedpods
Longer large logs for balancing and climbing	Mud/ mud kitchen
Stones/rocks, pebbles of varying	Water
textures and sizes	Seeds
Pine cones	Bark: paperbark or palm bark 'branches'
Bamboo in whole pieces or sliced in half and	Haybales/ straw
hollowed out to make tunnels	Ochre for painting
oTHER	Buckets
Tyres	Mortar and pestle
Crates	Gigging equipment
Ropes	Baskets
Tarps and pegs	Watering cans
Fabric – curtains, sheets	Pool noodles
Ribbon/wool to weave	Bags
Pipes/ hose pipes	Clothing – e.g. fluro vests, hard hats, crowns
Funnels	Small World toys – dinosaurs, fairy doors,
Guttering	small action figures, animals

	Recycled containers – milk bottles, foil
Plant pots	dishes
Kitchenware – e.g. pots, pans, cake tins,	Black/whiteboards and chalk/pens
spoons, sieves	Wheels – e.g. bike, scooter
Cardboard	Small trucks and vehicles
Bricks and blocks – foam, real, plastic	Paint brushes
Pulleys	Random interesting objects!
